We began our journey into exploring how we might **Build Buy-in for IB** with our special guest and inquiry expert, **Misty Paterson**.



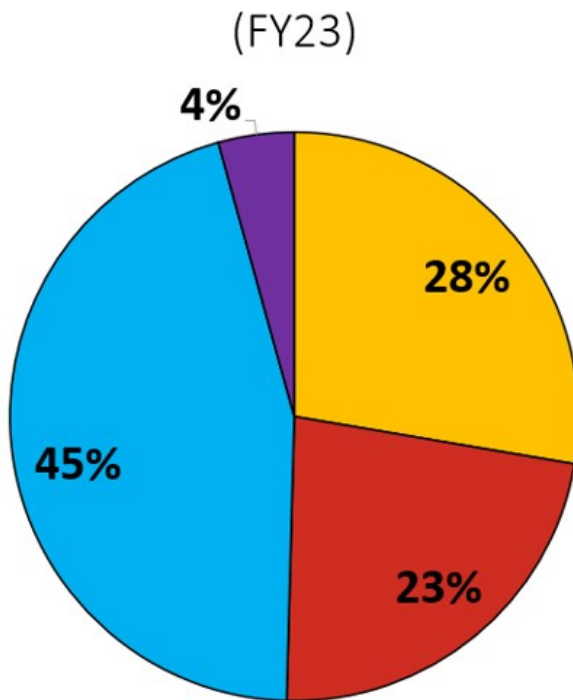

She inspired us to be inquiry finders and makers as we used our pens, papers, and other personal belongings as sites of inquiry. This experience reminded us that as Pedagogical Leaders, we have to continuously engage in PD that will empower us to help our staff grow in Approaches to Teaching. 2 Buy-in with Numbers: CASIE

Executive Director, John Denine, guided us as IB Leaders through an experience that allowed us to think about how we can paint the picture of the IB Landscape using facts and figures to our school community. We felt how numbers can serve as provocations to spark curiosity about our school's place in the IB's worldwide, national, and local contexts. The numbers presented and questions posed allowed space for storytelling, calculations, historical and societal wonderings, and predictions. We could see how we can likewise strategically draw in our colleagues into rich discussions about IB to gain more buy-in.

3 Buy-in with the IB Continuum:

We gained awareness of "Happenings" across the IB Continuum to empower ourselves to speak with more knowledge as IB Leaders. For the **PYP**, we saw that the IB conducted research on how **PYP implementation impacts school climate**. For **MYP**, we viewed the goals of the work the IB is doing in the **Enhancing the MYP multi-year project**. For the **DP & CP**, we briefly examined the IB's position on adopting DP courses school-wide and their invitation to become a partner to the **Schoolwide Adoption Project**.

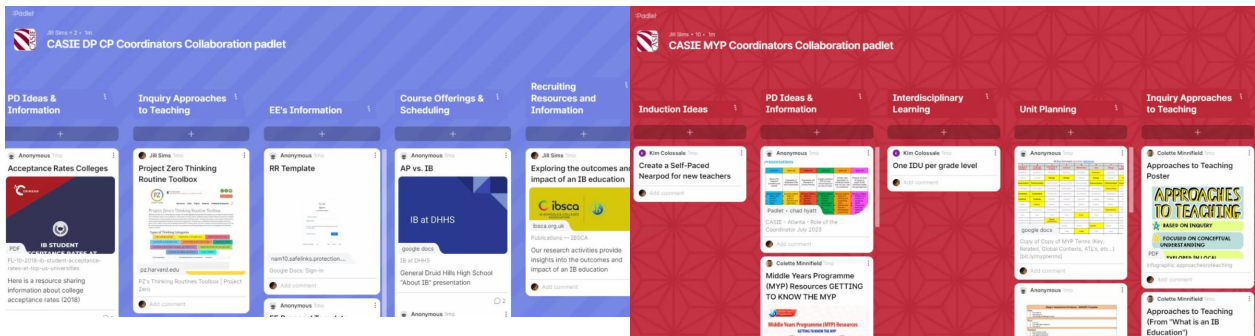

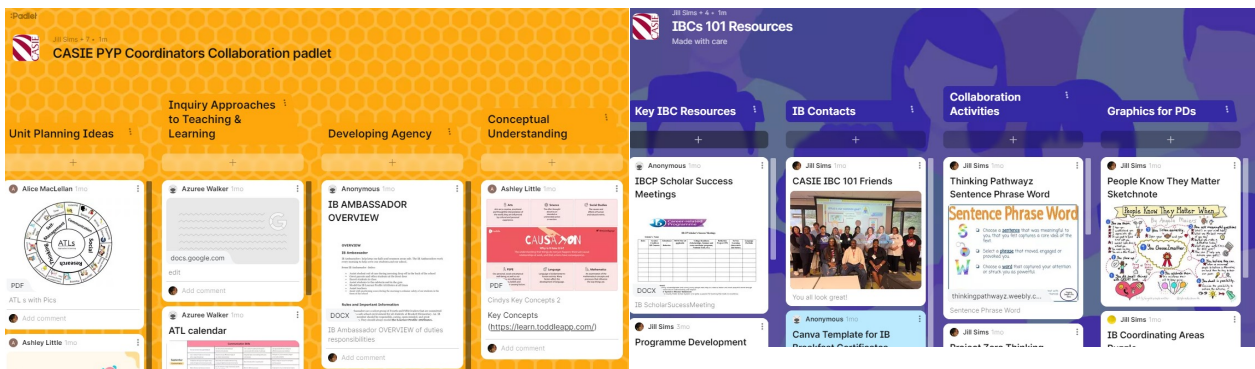
